Bus trips especially due to the exposure to public areas and not being able to safely distance. We will continue outdoor events using the COVID-safe guidelines that are in place at the time. 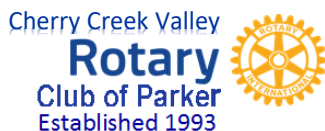
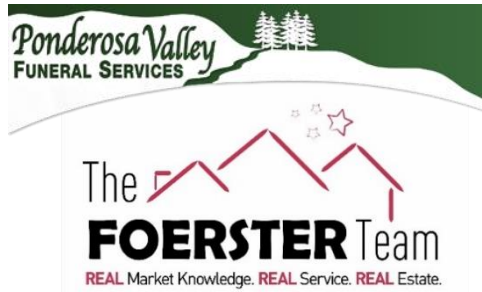
