for our Parking Lot

PLEASE READ – STRICTLY ENFORCED – NO EXCEPTIONS

- ❖ Members only. Because we have limited space, this event is **not open to the pubic**. Exception: You may ride with family or friends if you all remain in **one** car.
- ❖ You are required to remain in your vehicle at all times. Absolutely no exiting your vehicle before, during, or after the event. No walk-ins or standing.
- ❖ Vehicles will be parked with one empty space between. Volunteers will guide you to the correct parking space. They will do their best to assign spaces to optimize viewing.
- ❖ After the event, departure will be done safely. Please wait until the parking attendant dismisses you.
- One restroom will be available for use inside the building. Admitted only by a volunteer. Restroom will be sanitized after each use.
- ❖ In the case of **inclement weather**, the event will be moved to the very next day (Thursday).
- Please help us continue this great event by abiding by these safety guidelines.
